Direct recruitment of **Senior Lecturers / Lecturers** in the
Directorate of Teacher Education, Research & Training and
in the District Institute of Education and Training -2006-07

PROSPECTUS

1. Government of Tamil Nadu proposes to recruit Senior Lecturers / Lecturers for the Directorate of Teachers Education, Research and Training, and the District Institutes of Education and Training.
2. The posts will be filled up on the basis of marks secured in a written competitive examination to be conducted by the Teachers' Recruitment Board, and following communal reservation of 69% (30% for Backward Class, 20% for Most Backward Class 18% for Scheduled Caste and 1% for Scheduled Tribe candidates). Open competition posts will be 31%. The reservation of vacancies for Women (30%), Physically handicapped (1%) and Blind (2%) (for non-Science subjects and languages only) will be followed as per Government orders in force.
3. The estimated vacancies for Senior Lecturers / Lecturers are given in Annexure-I

5. **Qualifications:**

I. Senior Lecturers: Candidates should possess M.A./M.Sc. with at least 50% marks, M.Ed., with 55% marks, and Teaching Experience of atleast 5 years in any recognized Teacher Training Institute/ DIET in the State. Provided that holders of M.Ed., Degree with less than 55% marks, apart from the possession of experience of 5 years in DIET/TTIs, should also have an experience for a further period of 5 years in Elementary Schools or in handling standards VI to VIII in a recognized school.

II. Lecturers: Candidates should possess M.A./M.Sc. with atleast 50% marks, and M.Ed., with 55% marks. Provided that holders of M.Ed., Degree with less than 55% marks, should have teaching experience of 5 years in Elementary Schools or in handling standards VI to VIII in a recognized school.

All degrees should be from UGC/NCTE recognised Universities only. The candidate should possess knowledge of Tamil of 10th Standard level.

6. **Age:** Candidates should not be over 57 years as on 1-7-2006, as the age of superannuation is 58 years.

7. a) **Blind candidates** should possess certificate in prescribed format from Medical Officer not below the rank of Civil Surgeon for one of the following: (i) Total absence of sight, or (ii) Visual acuity not exceeding 6/60 or 20/200 (snellen) in the better eye with correcting lenses or (iii) Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of 20 degrees or worse. (One-eyed blind persons cannot claim reservation against Blind or PHO category). Blind candidates will be allowed assistance of scribes who are not degree holder in the respective subject.

b) **Physically handicapped** candidates should possess certificate in prescribed format from Medical Officer not below the rank of Civil Surgeon for at least 40% disability.

8. **Community Certificate:** Permanent Community Card Certificate obtained from the under-mentioned authorities on or before the last date for submission of the Application form is necessary for candidates claiming reservation category.

- a) ST - Revenue Divisional Officer dated after 11-11-1989
- b) SC - Tahsildar of native taluk of the candidate
- c) BC / MBC / DNC - Headquarters Deputy Tahsildar or Special Deputy Tahsildar

Note: Married women should possess Community Certificate issued in father's name only.

9. **Application/Examination Fee:** I.C.R. Application forms along with Prospectus and Syllabus for the written competitive examination can be obtained in person from the Offices of the Chief Educational Officers concerned (Annexure-II) on payment of Rs.500/- (Rs.250/- for SC/ST and Blind candidates of all communities) by Demand Draft. The fee is payable by a crossed Demand Draft in favour of "Teachers Recruitment Board, Chennai" payable at Chennai. Demand draft should be from any one of the following Banks.

The candidate should write his/her name, Application number and Subject for which applied, in English on the reverse of the Demand Draft.

10. **Submission of Application Form:** Candidates are advised to submit the filled-in forms in person at the Office of the Chief Educational Officer concerned, on or before the last date for submission announced in the Press and Notification, and obtain acknowledgement for the same. Application received in any form other than the one issued by Teachers' Recruitment Board shall be rejected.

Note: Candidates can submit their Application form at any Office of the Chief Educational Officers (Annexure-II).

11. **Scheme of Examination:** The written examination will consist of a single paper of 3 hours duration with 150 marks. The question paper will be of objective type with multiple-choice questions. The marks allotted to the Main Subject, Educational Methodology and General Knowledge are as follows:

Main subject	70 marks
Education Methodology	70 marks
General Knowledge	10 marks

The candidates are required to answer the questions in the special OMR answer sheet provided, by shading a single answer for each question in blue or black ball-point pen only.

12. **The Date and Venue of Examinations:**

I. Senior Lecturers:

The Examination will be held on Sunday **15-10-2006** from 10-00 AM to 1-00 PM. The Examination will be held in **Chennai** only. The venue for the Examination will be intimated in the Hall Tickets. The Hall Tickets will be sent by Teachers Recruitment Board directly to the eligible candidates. Decision of Chairman, Teachers' Recruitment Board on eligibility of the candidate to sit for the Examination will be final.

II. Lecturers:

The Examination will be held on Sunday, **8-10-2006** from 10-00 AM to 1-00 PM. The Examination will be held in **all 30 District** Headquarters. The venue for the Examination will be intimated in the Hall Tickets. The Hall Tickets will be sent by Teachers Recruitment Board directly to the eligible candidates. Decision of Chairman, Teachers' Recruitment Board on eligibility of the candidate to sit for the Examination will be final.

13. **Selection:** Provisional selection will be done on the basis of the marks scored in the written competitive examination, and following communal rotation. The Roll-Number-wise Mark List of all candidates, and Roll numbers of candidates short-listed for Certificate Verification in the ratio of 1:1, based on written examination marks, will be published in the website of TRB viz. <http://trb.tn.nic.in> and TRB Notice Board. The publication of results will be announced through Press / Media.

14. **Certificate Verification:** Candidates short-listed as above shall bring the original and attested copies of all Certificates as stated in the call letters for Certificate Verification. All Certificates (except Teaching Experience) should have been issued prior to the last date for the receipt of filled-in Applications by Teachers' Recruitment Board. Certificates issued after the cut-off date will not be considered. Teaching experience certificate issued by Principal / Headmaster of the DIET/TTI/Elementary School, should be countersigned by the Inspecting Officer concerned. (*Specimen copy of Teaching Experience Certificate is attached*). The final result, after Certificate Verification will be published in TRB website.

15. **No T.A./D.A.** will be paid, Candidates will have to bear their own expenses to attend the written Examination and the Certificate Verification at Teachers Recruitment Board Chennai, if called.

16. The **final eligibility** of the candidates will be subject to the decision of Teachers Recruitment Board. Decision of Chairman, Teachers' Recruitment Board on all matters concerned with the Examination will be final and binding.

Note: Calling for Certificate Verification is not a guarantee for selection.

17. Special Instructions:

- a) The Application Forms should be carefully filled up. The latest passport size photograph should be pasted in the space provided and should not be stapled. The photograph should not be attested and it should be free from any mark, as the same has to be used for printing the Hall Tickets.
- b) The candidate should write his/her Name, Subject, Application Form No. and the post applied for, on reverse of the Demand Draft.
- c) The Application form should not be folded. The Application form and the Demand Draft should be submitted in the envelope issued along with the form.
- d) The candidates are requested to draw the Demand Draft for Rs.500/- / Rs.250/- (Application/Examination Fees) in favour of 'Teachers Recruitment Board, Chennai-6' payable at Chennai, from any one of the Banks mentioned in the Application form. The name of the Bank and Bank code are to be entered in the Application form as per the codes given in the form.
- e) The codes of the Examination District are given in the Annexure. The candidates are requested to mention the code of the District in which they would like to write the examination in the Application form in the space provided under " Examination City", and also the name of the city/town in the space provided.
- f) The Subject code should be clearly filled up in the space allotted in the Application form.
