1. Government of Tamil Nadu proposes to recruit **Lecturers** (Senior Scale) for appointment in Government Law Colleges, through Written Competitive Examination and Interview, to be conducted by the Teachers Recruitment Board.
2. The posts will be filled up on the basis of marks scored in the written competitive examination and Interview marks, following communal reservation.
3. **Pay:** Rs.10,000-325-15,200

5. **Communal Reservation:** 30% for Backward Class, 20% for Most Backward Class, 18% for Scheduled Caste and 1% for Scheduled Tribe candidates. The reservation guidelines set out in G.O.Ms.No.105, P&AR Dept, dated 20.6.2000 will be followed.
6. **Qualifications**
  - (i) Master's degree in Law of any recognised University with not less than 55% of marks and a good academic record;  
 Provided that candidates belonging to Schedule Caste and Scheduled Tribe shall possess not less than 50% marks;  
 Provided further that holders of Ph.D in Law, who have passed their Master's degree in Law prior to 19<sup>th</sup> September, 1991, shall possess not less than 50% marks in the Master's degree in Law.
  - (ii) Must have qualified in the National Eligibility Test (NET) or State Level Eligibility Test (SLET); and
  - (iii) Must have enrolled as an Advocate in the Bar;  
 Provided that other things are being equal, preference shall be given to persons who have actual experience at the Bar or Teaching experience.
7. **Age:** For BC, MBC and SC/ST candidates the age should not be over 57 years as on 1.7.2006. For other candidates the age should not be over 40 years as on 1-7-2006; provided that for each year of service, whether regular or temporary, rendered in any of the teaching posts in a Law College in the State by a candidate, the age limit will be increased by one year, subject to a maximum of 5 years.
8. **Application/Examination fee:** ICR Application forms along with Prospectus and Syllabus for the written competitive examination can be obtained in person from the Office of the Teachers Recruitment Board, Chennai-6 on payment of **Rs.500/-** (Rs.250/- for SC/ST) by a crossed Demand Draft in favour of "Teachers Recruitment Board, Chennai" payable at Chennai. Demand draft should be from any one of the following Banks.

01 State Bank of India    02 Indian Bank    03 Indian Overseas Bank    04 Canara Bank

The candidate should write his/her name, Application number and Subject for which applied, in English on the reverse of the Demand Draft. The Application/Examination fee paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

Those who wish to get the application form by post may send a request letter with full postal address of the candidate along with DD for Rs.550/- (Rs.300/- for SC/ST) being the Application/Examination fee plus postal charges, to reach this office on or before 20.12.2006. (No enclosures other than DD are to be sent). The Application form will not be sent if (i) full address is not mentioned in the request letter, or (ii) DD for Rs.550/- (Rs.300/ for SC/ST) is not enclosed with request letter.

9. **Filled-in Application Form:** Should be submitted to the Teachers Recruitment Board, Chennai-6, on or before 29-12-2006
