**Direct recruitment of Lecturers**  
for Government Engineering Colleges/Polytechnics (2006-07)

**PROSPECTUS**

The Government of Tamil Nadu proposes to recruit Lecturers for Government Engineering Colleges/Polytechnic Colleges. Applications are invited from qualified candidates for the written competitive examination. The posts will be filled up on the basis of marks secured in the written competitive examination, and weightage marks awarded after Certificate Verification, following communal reservation.

- 1. Scale of Pay:** Rs.8,000-275-13,500
- 2.** The **estimated vacancies** (tentative) are given in [Annexure-I](#).
- 3. Reservation:** Communal reservation will be as follows: 30% for Backward Class, 20% for Most Backward Class, 18% for Scheduled Caste and 1% for Scheduled Tribe candidates. Open Competition vacancies will be 31%. The reservation of vacancies for Women (30%), Orthopaedically handicapped (1%) and Blind (2%) (for non-Science subjects and languages only) will be followed as per Government orders in force.
- 4. Minimum Qualifications:**

Post	Qualifications
Lecturers (Engineering Subjects)	A <b>First Class Bachelor's degree</b> from a recognised University in the branch of Engineering relating to the post concerned
Lecturers (Non-Engineering Subjects) (English/Maths/Physics/Chemistry/Geology)	A <b>First Class Master's degree</b> from a recognised University in the appropriate branch of study.

Candidate may apply only for the subjects for which the vacancies are notified and subject code numbers assigned. Tamil language test should have been passed at SSLC level. If not, he/she should pass Tamil language test conducted by TNPSC/DGE within two years after selection.

- 5. Age:** Candidates should not have completed 57 years of age, as on 1-7-2007.
- 6. Community:** Permanent Community Card Certificate obtained from the under-mentioned authorities is absolutely necessary for candidates claiming reservation category. (a) ST - Revenue Divisional Officer dated after 11-11-1989, (b) SC - Tahsildar of native taluk of the candidate (c) BC/MBC/DNC – Headquarters' Deputy Tahsildar or Special Deputy Tahsildar of the candidate's native Taluk. Community is inherited from father only, hence the father's name should have been mentioned as 'son of/daughter of' in the Community Certificate, even for the married women. Community Certificates issued by other States are not valid.
- 7. Blind & Handicapped:**
  - (a) Blind:** candidates should possess certificate in prescribed format from Medical Officer not below the rank of Civil Surgeon for one of the following: (i) Total absence of sight on both eyes, *or* (ii) Visual acuity not exceeding 6/60 or 20/200 (snellen) in the better eye with correcting lenses *or* (iii) Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of 20 degrees or worse. One-eyed blind persons cannot claim reservation against Blind category.
  - (b) Handicapped:** Orthopaedically handicapped candidates should possess certificate in prescribed format from Medical Officer not below the rank of Civil Surgeon for at least 40% disability.

**Note:** All Certificates should have been obtained prior to the last date for submission of filled-in Applications announced in the recruitment notification published in newspapers.

- 8. Application Form/Fee:** The computer-readable Application form along with Prospectus and Syllabus for the written competitive examination can be obtained in person from the Offices of the Principals of Engineering Colleges/Polytechnic Colleges or from the Office of the Chief Educational Officer, as the case may be (*Annexure-II*) on payment of **Rs.600/-** (Rs.300/- for SC/ST and, blind candidates of all communities) by Demand Draft. The fee includes Examination Fee, which cannot be refunded under any circumstance. The fee is payable by a crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of "**Teachers Recruitment Board, Chennai**" payable at '**Chennai**'. The Demand draft should be from any one of the following Banks only.

The candidate should write his/her Name, Application Number and Subject for which applied, in English only, on the reverse of the Demand Draft.

- 9. Submission of Form:** Candidates are advised to submit the filled-in forms in person at the Offices of the Principals of Engineering Colleges/Polytechnic Colleges/Office of the Chief Educational Officer, as the case may be, on or before the last date for receipt of filled-in forms, announced in the Advertisement and to obtain acknowledgement on the photocopy of the filled and signed application form. Applications received in any form other than the one issued by the above officers shall be rejected.

**Note:** Candidates can obtain the form from any district and submit the filled-in form in any district irrespective of the examination city preferred (*Annexure-II & III*.)

- 10. Scheme of Examination:** The written examination will consist of a single paper of 3-hour duration with 190 marks. The question paper will be of objective type with multiple choice questions. The question paper will be based on the Syllabus for the subject issued along with the application form. The marks allotted to the Main Subject and General Knowledge are as follows:

The Question Papers for all subjects will be in English. The candidates are required to answer the questions in the special OMR answer sheet provided, by shading a single answer for each question in blue or black ball-point pen only.

- 11. Examination:** The written Examination will be held on Sunday, **07-10-2007** from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM in 10 District Headquarters (*Annexure-III*). The venue for the Examination will be intimated in the Admit Card. The Admit Cards will be sent by Teachers Recruitment Board directly to the eligible candidates. If the Admit Card is not received before 2 days of the examination date, the candidate may refer our website for details. The candidate will be allowed for examination after verifying his/her identity with the nominal roll in Exam centre before the examination day. Blind candidates will be allowed assistance of Scribes, who are not Graduates/Postgraduates in the respective Subjects. The decision of Chairman, Teachers Recruitment Board on the eligibility of the candidate to sit for the Examination will be final.
- 12. Examination Results:** (i) The Written Examination Marks of all candidates will be released in the website of TRB viz. <http://trb.tn.nic.in> by notifying the release of results in the Press/Media. (ii) The merit list of candidates short-listed for Certificate Verification, in the ratio of **1:2**, based on written examination marks following the communal reservation, will also be published in the website as well as in the Notice Board of TRB. If more than one candidate secures the same lowest cut-off mark for a particular communal turn, all such candidates will be called for CV. Hence the number of candidates called for CV may be slightly higher than twice the number of vacancies.

- 13. Certificate Verification :** Candidates, short-listed as above, should bring the original and attested copies of all certificates to the CV centre at Chennai, as stated in the call letter for Certificate Verification. **Weightage marks** as shown below will be awarded after Certificate Verification.

i	For Teaching experience of two years and above in a recognised college	2 marks
ii	For M.E. Degree from a recognised University in the branch of Engineering relating to the post concerned	3 marks
	For M.Phil. Degree from a recognised University in the appropriate branch of study in the non-engineering subject	
iii	For Ph.D. in the relevant subject	5 marks

These marks will be added to written Examination marks for preparing the final merit-cum-communal selection list. Teaching Experience Certificate, issued by Principal of the institution in the prescribed form (*Specimen copy of the Teaching Experience Certificate is attached in Annexure-IV*) and countersigned by the officer concerned, should be produced. The Teaching Experience Certificate could be obtained after the cut-off date, but the period of service shall be counted upto the cut-off date only. The certificates for higher qualifications, shown above, should have been obtained before the last date of submission of filled-in application forms.

- 14. Selection:** The provisional list of candidates selected for appointment after Certificate Verification and after addition of weightage marks for the short-listed candidates, will be published in the Notice Board of TRB and in the website of TRB viz. <http://trb.tn.nic.in> by notifying the release of final result in the Press/media. Intimation to the provisionally selected candidates will also be sent by post individually. The final eligibility of the candidates will be subject to the decision of Teachers Recruitment Board. The appointment orders will be issued by the Director of Technical Education, Chennai-25.
- 15. No T.A./D.A.** will be paid. Candidates will have to bear their own expenses to attend the Written Examination in districts and for Certificate Verification at Teachers Recruitment Board Chennai, if called.
- 16. Filling the form:**
- The Application Forms should be carefully filled up. The passport size photograph should be pasted in the space provided and should not be stapled. The photograph should not be attested and it should be free from any mark, as the same has to be used for printing the Admit Cards.
  - The Application form should not be folded. The Application form should be submitted in the envelope issued along with the form.
  - The candidate should enter the Examination City Code and name of Examination City in which they would like to write the examination as given in *Annexure-III*.
  - The Subject code should be clearly filled up in the space allotted in the Application form. The name of the subject should be entered exactly as shown in side 2 of the application form, then only the subject name could be accommodated within the boxes allotted.
  - As the form is computer readable and pre-programmed, any information written outside the boxes provided will not be read by the computer. Hence, altering the form or adding any additional box will result in, your application becoming invalid.
  - A photocopy of the filled and signed application form with acknowledgement may be preserved.
